Music Director opening at the Church of the Epiphany, Euclid

The Church of the Epiphany in Euclid, an Episcopal congregation, is looking for an Organist/Choir Director. We use a blend of classical and other traditional music along with the organ and piano for services. Proficiency in both organ and piano is desired and the ability to lead a choir of adults of all musical abilities, as well as occasional instrumentalists during services is required.

The position is open to people of any faith, but a strong sense of worship, and a willingness to learn our liturgy and engage with the whole church community, is appreciated. The Church of the Epiphany is open to new ways to express our faith through music.

Responsibilities include:

- One Sunday service per week at 10 am, which includes congregational hymns and usually a choir anthem during the program year, along with a prelude and postlude; the service is usually around an hour long;
- Special services seasonally, such as at Advent, Christmas, Lent, Holy Week, Easter, and the feast of the Epiphany, with rehearsal as needed;
- One weeknight choir rehearsal (after Labor Day through Trinity Sunday), about one hour long;
- Assist and advise the priest in choosing music;
- Monitor the care and maintenance of the organ and piano, making appropriate recommendations as needed, within the budget set by Vestry;
- Acquire music and needed accessories within the budget set by Vestry;
- The Music Director may receive an honorarium for funerals and weddings, subject to agreement.

Our organ is an Allen two manual electronic installed in 1981.

The anticipated salary range is from \$11,000-\$12,000 annually. Four weeks' vacation per year is included, not to be taken during High Holy days. This position is not eligible for pension or other benefits.
